It is my own eager expectation and hope, that [looking toward the future] I will not disgrace myself *nor* be ashamed in anything, but that with courage *and* the utmost freedom of speech, even now as always, Christ will be magnified *and* exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. AMP

1. RUGGED ANTICIPATION - "I eagerly expect and hope"

- EAGER excited, focused, leaning in, fully ready, "let's Go!!!"
- EXPECT Assuming something
- HOPE Looking forward to it, confident, belief in a desired future

2. STRONG CLARIFICATION - "I will in no way be ashamed"

- Everything I do in public would honour Him
- Everything I do in private would honour Him
- NO WAY Nothing I do would cause me to feel ashamed
- ASHAMED embarrassed, regretful, humiliated,
- 3. BOLD DETERMINATION "but will have sufficient courage"
 - Radical commitment
 - Fearless follow-through
 - Won't be a whussy Push through my fears
 - STAY IN MY LANE control what I can control
 - No holding back.
 - Bravely do what I know I need to do

4. CLEAR CONTINUATION - "so that now as always"

- Today, tomorrow, the Next Day the Same Thing

- Consistency reliable
- Finish Strong

5. LIFE EXULTATION - "Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death."

- Everything I do Points to HIM and what He has done in my life.
