HEBREWS 10:22-25 NIV

²² let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴ And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

HEBREWS 10:22-25 NLT

²² let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ's blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water. ²³ Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. ²⁴ Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. ²⁵ And *let us not neglect our meeting together*, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

Hebrews 10:22-25 TPT

"We come closer to God and approach him with an open heart, fully convinced that nothing will keep us at a distance from him. For our hearts have been sprinkled with blood to remove impurity, and we have been freed from an accusing conscience. Now we are clean, unstained, and presentable to God inside and out! So now wrap your heart tightly around the hope that lives within us, knowing that God always keeps his promises! Discover creative ways to encourage others and to motivate them toward acts of compassion, doing beautiful works as expressions of love. This is not the time *to pull away and neglect meeting together*, as some have formed the habit of doing. In fact, we should come together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward as we anticipate that day dawning."

To "SHOW UP" means to continue to attend, to be there, to be present in mind and body, to come to learn, be engaged, involved and fully participate.

Being a "**NO SHOW**" is to walk away, to start missing, to quit attending, to drop out, to disengage, to separate from others and to isolate and full walk alone.

The Opposite of Addiction is Connection!

What Does SHOWING UP Mean according to Hebrews 10:22-25

- 1. SHOW UP to GOD by taking STEPS IN GETTING CLOSER TO HIM. Draw Near to Him.
- 2. SHOW UP with an AUTHENTIC SINCERE HEART
- 3. SHOW UP Knowing you are CLEAN because of JESUS Relief from a GULITY CONSCIENCE.
- 4. SHOW UP with the HOPE that God wants to change you, can change you and will change you!
- 5. SHOW UP knowing GOD IS FAITHFUL.
- 6. SHOW UP to MOTIVATE OTHERS to Grow and Change
- 7. DON'T QUIT SHOWING UP Keep Meeting Together Don't be a "NO SHOW"
- 8. DON'T FOLLOW THE "NO SHOW" as the habit of some are doing.
- 9. SHOW UP to ENCOURAGE Others and Call each other to GREATNESS
- 10. SHOW UP knowing that JESUS will Come Again Show Yourself Ready and Waiting.

Men make Men!

Opening up and becoming known and accountable to other men is a clear anchor point of recovery. Men can call each other to Greatness, women can't. It is hard to receive correction from anyone but other trusted men who know you are the best ones to speak into your life!

- 1. Show Up to REGROUP Be Regular
- 2. Show Up to Break Out Groups It is there that you become known.
- 3. Show Up with the Camera We a person not a blank screen.
- 4. Show Up with a Good Attitude to Learn and Receive God's Truth
- 5. Show Up to Encourage
- 6. Show Up when Struggling
- 7. Show Up in the Discussion
- 8. Show Up with Phone Calls
- 9. Show Up on What's App Add your Input and Support
- 10. Show Up in Prayer for One Another
- 11. Show Up Online when Tempted Reach Out
- 12. Show Up in Recovery Work Work with Others.
