

The Secrets of Re-Romancing Your Spouse

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The More You Apply these Seven Secrets of Romancing Your Spouse, the More in Turn You Will Enjoy Your Life!

1. LIVE TO PLEASE HER

- 1 Cor. 7:33,34 - But a married man is concerned about the affairs of this world—how he can please his wife—³⁴ and his interests are divided. An unmarried woman or virgin is concerned about the Lord's affairs: Her aim is to be devoted to the Lord in both body and spirit. But a married woman is concerned about the affairs of this world—how she can please her husband.
- Phil. 2:3,4 - Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
- Your "I do" at the altar creates an "I will" in life.
- Goal is to please his wife regarding the things of this world.
- Put her needs and interests before your own.
- God will gauge your success in life on how big a smile you bring to her.

2. LIVE TO PAMPER HER

- 1 Peter 3:7 - Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.
- Prov. 31:10-12- A wife of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies. Her husband has full confidence in her and lacks nothing of value. She brings him good, not harm, all the days of her life.
- Treat her with gentleness
- Speak to her with respect
- She needs to feel safe with you.
- Express your gratitude and encouragement

3. LIVE TO PROVIDE FOR HER

- 1 Timothy 5:4,8 – But if a widow has children or grandchildren, these should learn first of all to put their religion into practice by caring for their own family and so repaying their parents and grandparents, for this is pleasing to God. Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.
- Commit to take care of her and the family.
- God calls us to responsible for the life and future.
- Work to pay the way through your effort and your wisdom.

4. LIVE TO PROVE YOURSELF WITH HER

- 1 Cor. 13:7 – If you love someone, you will be loyal to him no matter what the cost. You will always believe in him, always expect the best of him, and always stand your ground in defending him.
- Malachi 2:14-16 – You ask, “Why?” It is because the LORD is the witness between you and the wife of your youth. You have been unfaithful to her, though she is your partner, the wife of your marriage covenant. ¹⁵ Has not the one God made you? You belong to him in body and spirit. And what does the one God seek? Godly offspring. ¹⁴ So be on your guard, and do not be unfaithful to the wife of your youth. ¹⁶ “The man who hates and divorces his wife,” says the LORD, the God of Israel, “does violence to the one he should protect,” ¹⁵ says the LORD Almighty. So be on your guard, and do not be unfaithful.
- A real man is faithful to his wife.
- Loyal to her both publically and privately
- Refuse to break faith with her or your marital covenant
- Leave no doubts about her exclusiveness to you.

5. LIVE TO PAY THE PRICE FOR HER

- Eph. 5:25-31 - Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her ²⁶to make her holy, cleansing^[a] her by the washing with water through the word, ²⁷and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. ²⁸In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed and care for their body, just as Christ does the church— ³⁰for we are members of his body. ³¹“For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.”^[b]
- Love her like Jesus loved us...unconditional sacrifice.
- When is the last time you hung on a cross for your wife.
- You may be willing to die for her but will you help around the house?

6. LIVE TO PURSUE HER

- Prov. 5:15-19 - Drink water from your own cistern, running water from your own well. ¹⁶Should your springs overflow in the streets, your streams of water in the public squares? ¹⁷Let them be yours alone, never to be shared with strangers. ¹⁸May your fountain be blessed, and may you rejoice in the wife of your youth. ¹⁹A loving doe, a graceful deer—may her breasts satisfy you always, may you ever be intoxicated with her love.
- 1 Cor. 7:2-4- “Sexual drives are strong, but marriage is strong enough to contain them and provide for a balanced and fulfilling sexual life in a world of sexual disorder. The marriage bed must be a place of mutuality—the husband seeking to satisfy his wife, the wife seeking to satisfy her husband. Marriage is not a place to “stand up for your rights.” Marriage is a decision to serve the other, whether in bed or out.”
- Always be captivated by her love.
- Provide for her emotional needs.
- Become her best friend.
- Focus on learning how to meet her sexual needs.

7. LIVE TO PUT GOD FIRST WITH HER

- Psalm 127:1 - Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labor in vain. Unless the LORD watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain.
- Matt. 6:33 - But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- Prov. 3:5,6 - Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will direct your path.
- Put God First – Life Goes Best!
- Let the Lord Build the House – Put Him in the Middle.
- Lead by example and then lead in commitment together.
- Praying together daily.
